## What to expect from September 2021

### Campus based students

You will mainly learn on campus with some theory sessions taking place online.

## Safety and testing measures

### AMBER PHASE

Limited national restrictions but Coronavirus high in general population (expected September 2021)

#### Testing & Isolation

- Supported testing will be offered during Welcome Week with home testing continuing weekly throughout the month
- Your tutors and support staff will be encouraged to continue testing twice per week
- You must isolate if you (or someone in your household) tests positive for Coronavirus

**If you feel unwell you should remain at home and visit a test centre if symptomatic**

#### Risk Mitigation factors

- Mask wearing will be encouraged in communal areas
- Option for you to wear a mask in the classroom if you would prefer
- Regular cleaning and hand-washing

#### Food and drink

- You will be able to purchase food on campus and our refectories will be open

### GREEN PHASE

Limited national restrictions and Coronavirus low in general population

**If you feel unwell you should remain at home and visit a test centre if symptomatic**

- Option for you to wear masks on campus
- Regular cleaning and hand-washing

- You will be able to purchase food on campus and our refectories will be open

### RED PHASE

Significant new risk identified by government

- We will communicate any new government guidance to you ahead of rules changing

**If you feel unwell you should remain at home and visit a test centre if symptomatic**

- We will review new risks and take a cautious approach, following guidance to ensure we maintain a safe environment for all
- Regular cleaning and hand-washing

- You will be able to purchase food but may be encouraged to take it back to classrooms to avoid mixing
